

nPOD Acceptance Criteria

Here at nPOD we are very grateful for our OPO partners and the time, effort you put forth to help us on our quest to find a cure for type 1 diabetes.

Please call nPOD 1-866-731-6585 when you have donors that meet the following criteria:

- Type 1 diabetes: Donors 30 years or less in age with a type 1 disease duration of 7 years or less.
- Transplant: Any donor with a history of type 1 diabetes who has received a pancreas or pancreas/kidney transplant.
- Autoantibody positive donors, with at least 1 or more autoantibodies, ≤ 30 years old (for those OPOs that screen with nPOD).
- Donors 3-18 years in age, all donors.
- Caucasian donors 15-25 years in age, with a BMI of <30. Healthy with a limited history of high risk behavior with either one, or both of the following HLA.
- 1. DR3 or DR17 (could also be reported as DRB1*0301, DRB1*0302, or DRB1*03 on some HLA testing)
- 2. DR4 and DQ8 (could also be reported as DQB1*0302 on some HLA testing)
- Donors with a diagnosis of cystic fibrosis, any age.
- Donors who are pregnant, any age.
