

## ZOOM WEBINAR PARTICIPATION GUIDE

Thank you for participating in the **13<sup>th</sup> Annual nPOD Scientific Meeting**. This year's meeting will be held as a virtual scientific session on the Zoom Webinar platform. This quick start guide gives you an introduction to the essentials of joining and participating in a Zoom webinar.

The Zoom webinar feature is intended for the presentation of information with limited interaction from participants. You can join the Annual Meeting by using the Zoom meeting URL provided in the official meeting agenda or by entering the meeting ID into the Zoom Web Portal, desktop app, or mobile app.

## Zoom Webinar vs. Meeting

What sort of Zoom event should you be using? Here's a breakdown of the difference between a Zoom webinar and a meeting.

- **Zoom Meetings:** All participants can talk and share their webcam video. Meetings are great for smaller groups and higher interactivity, such as when you're holding a team catch-up or getting in touch with a customer or prospect.
- **Zoom Webinars:** Webinars grant hosts more control over how participants engage. Webinars also enable several other features that aren't included in Zoom meetings. (We'll cover those features in more detail shortly.)

# How to join Annual Meeting Webinar

## Join via meeting agenda

1. From the final **Meeting Agenda** provided, click on the associated “Zoom Link”
2. Follow the prompts to download and install the Zoom desktop application.

NOTE: You will need to download and install the Zoom desktop application to use meeting chat and participate in polls. Make sure to use agenda with activated Zoom Meeting Link.



# Join the meeting via the Zoom Web Portal

1. Navigate to <https://www.zoom.us/join> in your browser.
2. Click **Join (Connect to a meeting)**.
3. Log in to WebAccess using your **Access Account user ID** and **password**, if prompted.
4. Enter the **Webinar ID** into the Meeting ID field.
5. Enter your **email address** and **name** in the fields provided.
6. Click **Join Webinar**.
