We are writing this letter with the hope that you and your colleagues will consider providing financial sponsorship for the 17th Annual Meeting of the Network for the Pancreatic Organ Donors with Diabetes.

Established in 2007, the Network for the Pancreatic Organ Donors with Diabetes (nPOD) is an innovative research effort to obtain pancreas and other tissues from rare organ donors with type 1 diabetes, and to promote collaborative research to uncover the causes of this devastating disease. The need to study the pancreas from these patients is clear: decades of research in mouse models have failed to fully unveil the pathogenesis of the disease, and we still lack effective therapies to prevent and control this disease and its progression.

Because nPOD supports type 1 diabetes research through collaboration – sharing tissues, data, and ideas – we organize this meeting to bring our investigators together every year. Over the years, the annual nPOD meeting has grown and become one of the premiere meetings in type 1 diabetes research worldwide, typically attracting over 250 participants. The annual meeting has a critical role in our progress: providing our scientists with a venue for discussing science and planning new studies.

From March 2nd-5th, 2025, nPOD will be hosting its 17th Annual Meeting in Clearwater, Florida. Meeting participants pay a registration fee and other travel fees to attend this event. Major support is also provided by the Breakthrough T1D (formerly JDRF), as well as the Leona M. and Harry B. Helmsley Charitable Trust. However, the costs of the meeting are not fully covered by those fees. Thus, we are hoping that your company would consider providing financial support to help us offset such costs.

We believe that a sponsorship of the nPOD meeting is relevant to the interests of your company, where you can showcase your products to a receptive audience and engage directly with researchers.
